Promise:

2/Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus [Phil.4:6,7].

3/Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass [Ps.37:5].

Some facts you need to know according **Let go**

1. Let go is **not** simple or easy, but **can** be done.

4. If we let go we become really free and therefore perfect in Him who is love, God abides in us [1Joh.4:16], we then know that in **all** things He shall sustain us.
